Description

Adapun konsepsi dan kajian teori-teori ilmu pengetahuan dari perspektif Barat dan Islam itu sangat berbeda khususnya mengenai keberadaan Allah sebagai pencipta segala sesuatu, dan keaslian semua pemikiran termasuk Sumber ilmu pengetahuan (*resource knowledge*) tidak ada Sumber lain kecuali Allah. Sejak Sumber ilmu pengetahuan datang dari yang ghaib, maksud dan tujuan daripada ilmu pengetahuan adalah tidak lain kecuali dihubungkan dengan yang ghaib dan kenyataan.
